1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to amalgamate/change, cancel or postpone any Classes should there be insufficient entries received or prevailing weather conditions and/or time restrictions.
2. The Organising Committee and BSJA Jersey accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
3. Local competitors taking part in the show must be fully paid up members of BSJA Jersey or take out day membership for showing on Saturday 29 April or Sunday 30 April. Showing competitors please note that headgear must comply with British Showjumping Rules. (Rule 101.3)
4. All horses and ponies, including visiting ones, must be aged four years or over (foaled in or before 2019) and registered with BSJA Jersey and ridden by members in accordance with the prevailing British Showjumping Rules and BSJA Jersey Local Rules.
5. All British Showjumping Rules from the prevailing Rule Book as amended and 2023 Local Rules apply. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter a Class.
6. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6
7. In accordance with Rule 45.7 Ponies with over 300 points winnings must have a current JMB Height Certificate.
8. Please see schedule regarding the number of Classes that may be entered by horses and ponies on each day.
9. All **trophies** to be returned to the **BSJA Clubhouse by 22 April 2023**, clean and engraved. Failure to return a trophy will result in entries being refused and a fine being levied.
10. **Entries** can be made online www.bsjajersey.com. Refund of entry money will be paid in accordance with Rule 79.5
11. Entries will close 24 April 2023 for showing weekend and 01 May 2023 for jumping weekend. Late entries will be accepted after this at an additional charge.

CHALLENGE CLASS – Class 43 & 52

This class is run on the basis of the “Hickstead Masters” and is a one round class but in two sections (A & B).

First section (A) will be run over a course of 8-10 fences including a minimum of two doubles and will be judged under Table C. Approx Height Ponies 0.80cm). Competitors will register a time for the first section (A) and then proceed immediately on to the second section (B).

The finish flags for Section (A) and the start flags for section (B) will be placed together after the last jumping effort of Section (A).

Section (B) will consist of four vertical fences numbered 1-4, preferably in a straight line (on related distances) and of similar appearance. The fences will be built ascending in height from fence 1 to fence 4. (for example Ponies: 0.85/0.90/95/1.00). Section (B) will be judged under Table A.

Placings will be decided on faults incurred in section (B) and time recorded for section (A).

Start and finish flags must denote the start and finish of each section.

Single Phase Rule 287

Table A – both sections. Faults to be accumulated over both sections.

First and Second section with a time allowed and time limit. Second section against the clock.

The competitor will jump the whole course unless they are eliminated.

Number of fences: Five to seven fences in each section (minimum 10 fences maximum 13 fences overall).

Minimum of 12 numbered fences are mandatory for qualifying competitions. The second section must only comprise of new obstacles not previously used in the first section.

The height of the second section should be set higher than those set for the first section.

Speed to be included see Rule 161.

Accumulator Rule 274

The order of this class must be drawn. The competition takes place over six, eight or 10 obstacles which are progressively more difficult. No combination obstacles are allowed. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.

Speed 375m per minute in outdoor arenas, Ponies 350m per minute indoors and outdoors.

Points are awarded as follows: One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 21, 36 or 55 points. No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down.

Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A and any of these faults, including time faults, are converted into points and deducted from any jumping points scored.

This competition may also take place directly against the clock.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Eraser Fence. The Eraser must be more difficult than the alternative obstacle and means that four faults (if accumulated) can be taken from the competitors round. If the Eraser is knocked down, then four faults must be added to the total.

Table A7 Rule 192B

In the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

Table A8 Rule 192C

For competitions over one round and two jump-offs, the time is to be taken into consideration in each round in order to determine placings and qualifying positions in the event of equality of faults.

All those placed equal first go forward to the first jump-off. All those then placed equal first qualify for the second jump-off. Double clear points will only be awarded to those competitors that jump a double clear across all three rounds.

Table A10 Rule 192E

In the first round the second half of the course is to be built 5-10cm higher than the first half (except only 5cm for all National Amateur classes, Senior classes 1.10m and below and Pony classes 1.00m and below).

In the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round, and the jump-off course will be 5-10cm higher (except only 5cm for all National Amateur classes, Senior classes 1.10m and below and Pony classes 1.00m and below) than the second half of the first round.
